- A. Poll
 - 1. Since our last meeting, the school confirmed that we couldn't have the event there. We sent a poll out to students and parents and received 376 responses.
 - 2. Majority wanted an indoor event, didn't care when the event was held, and Spare Time was the event most preferred.
- B. Scheduled the event at Spare Time on Thursday, June 25th from 9 pm to 1 am
 - 1. Kids can check in between 8:45-9:30 pm and will start being released at 12:45 pm.
 - 2. Unlimited bowling, laser tag and video games
 - 3. Pizza, salad, breadsticks, tea and water will be provided kids can purchase sodas if they want to (only debit/credit cards accepted...they are "cashless" right now)
 - 4. Will provide celebratory cupcakes/cake/cookies of some sort
 - 5. Spare Time has detailed COVID sanitizing procedure that we will email out they have hand sanitizer stations throughout the venue and they will provide disposable gloves for anyone wanting to wear them they won't require masks, but they are encouraged (although that may change between now and then)
