I. Call to order - Justin Gonzalez at 7:05 pm

V. Treasurer's Report - Carly Gonzalez

A. Donation from Class of 2019 – Class of 2019 left approximately \$7,000 to the Class of 2020. Usually the class leaves approximately \$3,000 to the next class.

B. Pet Clinic proceeds – Pet Clinic was held August 19. We made approximately \$2100.

C. Balance of Bank Account – approximately \$9500

D. Draft of Budget for the year – Carly presented the Preliminary Budget that showed the actual budgets for 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 and then our preliminary budget for 2019-2020. She discussed that last year there were 850 seniors and 2020 has 459 seniors. We have a much smaller class and therefore don't need to raise as much money as they did for the class of 2019.

VI. Brief description of Senior Celebration – Carly gave a description of Senior Celebration and explained it is an event we sponsor to give graduates a drug and alcohol free event to celebrate graduation.

- B. What carries forward – Fundraising events – Justin suggested we choose not to do the events that previously made small amounts of money and focus on the largest ones that are more profitable. Those in attendance agreed with that.
